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✓ JUST SOME OF WHAT'S BEEN DELIVERED THIS TERM

Cleveland Town Centre results

- I achieved a city first in gaining initial support for a strategic Cleveland town centre management plan. This crucial innovative work can accelerate our combined revival efforts.
- A reference group to advise delivery of a well-connected, shaded, pedestrian and bike friendly centre is approved and is to be formed later in 2020.
- Extensive road resealing and improved line marking delivered in Doig St, Middle St, Kyling lane and Shore St west
- Council preparations have greatly assisted the Cleveland Central Shopping Centre purchase and now improvements including car park expansion underway.
- Construction of new medium density apartments will bring people to enliven our shops and streets.
- Councils strategic purchase of Cleveland Plaza (Bloomfield st)
- Councils contribution to the Kyling Corner revival as an entertainment hub.
- A new bud lighting policy has been delivered to enable motivated businesses to work with Council to "light up Cleveland"

Value for money and a financially responsible Council

- Delivered necessary tough budget repair from \$11 million deficit to a balanced budget over 4 years
- A new strategic community asset management tool developed to keep your \$2.3 Billion of community assets fit for purpose
- Low Council borrowings, No net debt, Strong cash balance
- I have helped place future Councils in a better position

Raby Bay Community results

- A fairer rating system. 80% of Raby Bay residents received a net reduction in combined rates and levies.
- Canal dredging and cleaning now 100% paid for by Council.
- Improved Storm tide mapping
- City plan special precinct rules are underway to better reflect community development expectations.
- Improving Revetment Wall maintenance and repair process
- Best ever collaboration with ratepayers association.

Recreation, parks and foreshore infrastructure

- \$3.6 Million dollar Cleveland Point land acquisition for public use
- \$7 million, 159 hectares of land purchased at Heinemann road for a multi-sport precinct to most likely include cycling, football and nature recreation zones following public consultation.
- \$2 million William Street Breakwater helping improving bay access and boating safety
- \$500 000 Station Masters Cottage delivered for Community use

Other Infrastructure

- \$20 million in local road and pathway improvements. Including the \$1 million Princess St "plastic" road.
- \$5 million in water and sewer upgrades and maintenance.
- Federal advocacy has facilitated ongoing local NBN rollout
- The Redlands Aquatic Centre has \$15 million allocated for its renewal or expansion within 8 years.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE, AS YOUR COUNCILLOR I WILL...

- Support smart and innovative technology & processes
- Seek ongoing funding for my proposed strategic management plan of Cleveland Town Centre projects, maintenance and investment attraction.
- Propose a Council led community and business consultation to formulate agreed parking reform in Cleveland. This should include the viability of a multi-deck facility close to the town centre.
- Support a multi-year budget allocation for major Council projects. Suitable catalytic projects, once proven, could be the \$5million Cleveland town centre smart lighting project, new sustainable Council premises or a multi-purpose car park.

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
