✓ JUST SOME OF WHAT'S BEEN DELIVERED THIS TERM

- Junner St loading ramp has been repaired and opened after years of delay
- Pt Lookout sewer and water mains expansion and repair work is now underway. These repairs will be staged over several years.
- Strong Federal advocacy for digital connectivity has assisted NBN construction rollout and highlighted mobile black spot requirements
- Cylinder Beach and commercial use area has received some modest operational works ahead of a new strategic plan
- Various research studies commenced in Cylinder Beach precinct to inform a much needed sustainable implementation plan.
- Council has further progressed the design of Snapper St pedestrian connection
- New Multi-use courts at Ron Stark Oval delivered
- Council continues funding and support for important local events including Intrust Rugby League, Straddie Salute triathlon, Chamber Music Festival and many more.
- Council grants totalling tens of thousands of dollars help support many Community groups including Stradbroke VMR, Stradbroke Early learning centre, Amity Cricket Club,
- Pt Lookout SLSC
- Over the last decade Council spends an average of \$6.5 Million annually to support Capital infrastructure and operational maintenance on Minjerrabah.
- Amity Point Shoreline erosion management plan delivered after 8 years. SEMP implementation plan in progress.
- \$1.5 million in Park renewal and expansion being delivered at Old Schoolhouse Park Amity, Point Lookout Oval and tennis courts, Cabarita Park Amity
- Council resealing and improved line-marking of it's car park for Straddie Flyer at Toondah Harbour
- Significant new Toondah harbour overflow car parking for use at peak periods created and delivered in this term
- Popular beach showers delivered at several Island locations
- Council disaster preparation and co-ordination in times of crisis has been high class and continues to improve
- There has been a consistent improvement in Council community engagement regarding projects and events.
- Regular Councillor township mobile offices and easy access over four years.

The stability & consistency of council representation is important to ongoing success. The relationships, trust and deep knowledge of the NSI community I have gained, will help deliver consistent results over the next 4 years.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE, AS YOUR COUNCILLOR I WILL...

- Seek sealing of Council owned gravel roads at Amity Point and at Pt lookout
- Support the budgeted road reseal at Yabby st One Mile
- Propose multi-year budget allocation for major projects such as Pt Lookout Sewering
- Ask Council to plan and partner to provide for more public amenities, showers and parking to better manage peak periods and locations.
- Encourage Council involvement in progressing the Amity to Dunwich and other off-road bike and pedestrian path connections in partnership with State, QYAC
- Request Snapper St pedestrian connection progress to construction
- Continue to advocate for a State gov led tourist and commuter transport solutions. This may include local business and Council support.
- Support sustainable Cylinder Beach plan with an Implimentation schedule
- Advocate to the current State government to fully fund and implement the Dunwich master plan and its own ETS strategies.
- Lobby for Stradbroke and Redlands coast Islands to be eligible for State regional infrastructure grants
